Eligibility and requirements are as follows: (*Please submit only 1 application*)

ELIGIBILITY:

The following criteria are used to determine the eligibility of applicants for the program:

1. A Scottish Rite Mason in the Valley of Toledo.
OR
A child of a Scottish Rite Mason in the Valley of Toledo.
OR
A grandchild of a Scottish Rite Mason in the Valley of Toledo. (*for the Valley of Toledo Scholarship **ONLY***)
OR
A member of a youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.
(*DeMolay, Rainbow, Job's Daughters*)
2. A current high school senior or a currently enrolled fulltime student at an accredited college or university.
3. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS:

1. A copy of your current "Fafsa - Student Aid Report" (SAR)
2. A letter of recommendation from a current school instructor, advisor, or counselor.
3. Your current school transcript which shows your cumulative GPA.

Submitting Applications:

The applicant must personally complete this application. The application and all supporting documents must be received by the Valley Office designated below, **NO LATER THAN 3:00 PM on MARCH 30th**. Applications **received after that date will not be considered**. Incomplete applications or faxed applications will not be considered.
